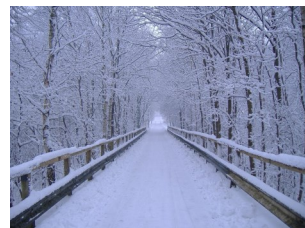
**How Do I Know “Weather” We’re Open?**
