Big Changes Are Coming

As part of the plan to have all facilities updated and in good repair, the Properties Team is managing a project to replace the second floor flooring and all the existing built-in cabinets in the Children's Building. The project will require classes to vacate the building, including removal of all classroom items to the gym. There will be some necessary space-sharing in the Wallis Building, so we can make room for both preschool and grade school classes. If you see some smaller people in your hallway between July 22 and August 5, please greet them warmly! Work will begin Monday, July 16 and hopes are that the project will be completed by Wednesday, August 8. Backpacks for Migrant Children

Did you know that there are four immigration detention centers in Virginia? One, in Bristow, sees 800 children, on average, pass through each year. We have been invited to join other congregations in the Bon Air Interfaith Network to collect new backpacks filled with items to meet children's basic needs. The goal is to collect 800 backpacks from among our community to send to the Bristow detention center. If you are interested in donating, take a collection list, found in our narthex, and return a filled backpack by Sunday, July 29 to the church office. This is not related to our South Richmond Baptist Center backpack drive and we ask you collect these in addition to those you plan to give to South Richmond.
