Are you a "Caring Cook"?

Caring Cooks is a group of individuals who provide home-cooked meals for family members of hospice patients at the Bon Secours Hospice House on Old Bon Air Road every other Wednesday of each month. Several of the Caring Cooks volunteer at the HRBC clinic, and they have asked us to help them expand their ministry so that working together we can provide meals more often. Each volunteer decides the number of times they wish to cook; most choose to help 2-3 times a year. This is usually done in teams of two; one may make a main dish while the other makes a side and a dessert, and the items are packaged into approximately 10 individual plastic containers, depending on the need each week. The Caring Cooks organization was established in 2016 with 25 volunteers, and now there are 31 of us.
