Christmastide (the festival season of Christmas) begins at midnight on Christmas Eve. It represents the 12 days of Christmas leading up to but not including the Epiphany. The Epiphany, celebrated on January 6 is the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles as represented by the Magi - Matthew 2:1-12. It is also known as King's Day and Old Christmas. The season of Epiphany lasts 8 Sundays (through March 3) and is symbolized by stars and the star of Bethlehem. It is followed by Ash Wednesday, March 6, 2019 which is also the beginning of Lent.
