A Moment of Lament for RVA
www.ForRichmond.org is an organization in Metropolitan Richmond that had its birth in 2009 as *BlessRVA*. Its purpose was to help pastors build relationships across racial and denominational divides. After the Unite the Right rally in Charlottesville in 2017, a group of 900 pastors and ministry leaders in Richmond came together to seek transformation and to pursue reconciliation in our city. As your pastor, it was my honor to gather around the statue of Maggie Walker to stand as one body of Christ for reconciliation and healing. Today, November 17, 2019 is set aside as a "Moment of Lament" around the commemoration of 400 years since enslaved Africans began arriving in the American colonies. We join *ForRichmond* in our prayers as we remember this broken and terrible part of our common history and to cry out to God for hope and healing in our land. God's peace, Pastor Bob
