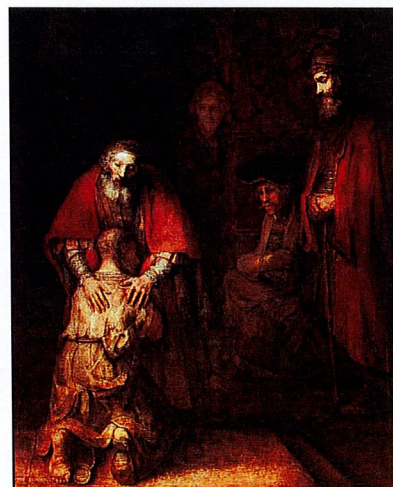


How to Unite with HRBC
