Discovering Your S.H.A.P.E. for Serving God

"Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others..." – 1 Peter 4:10

- **S = Spiritual Gifts** – What spiritual gifts has God given you to serve others?
- **H = Heart (Passion)** – What do you love doing? Who are you drawn to?
- **A = Abilities** – What talents or skills do you have?
- **P = Personality** – How has God uniquely wired you? Are you task-oriented, people-oriented, or a mix of both?
- **E = Experiences** – What life experiences has God used to shape you?
