**Key Thought:** You were made on purpose, for a purpose.

1. \_\_\_\_\_ — By grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. (Ephesians 2:8–9)
2. \_\_\_\_\_ — Formed by God’s hand, bearing His image. (Isaiah 43; Psalm 139)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ — Walking in the good works God prepared. (Ephesians 2:10)

#### Reflection Questions:

- How does knowing you are God’s masterpiece change the way you see yourself?
- Where might God be calling you to step into His “prepared works” this week?
- How does the Imago Dei shape your view of human dignity in a technological age?
