Key Thought: “When God’s Word is rediscovered and allowed to pierce our hearts, it leads to repentance, renewal, and a life transformed by grace.”

Today’s Takeaways:

1. Let God’s Word Break In...

- Rediscover Scripture; let it pierce your heart.
- Reflection: Am I being Christlike, not just biblical?

2. Start with Personal Repentance...

- Humble yourself before God; confess and surrender.
- Reflection: Where do I need God’s renewal first?

3. Live Out Public Reform...

- Faith shows itself in action — home, work, church, community.
- Reflection: How can my faith be visible and Christlike this week?
