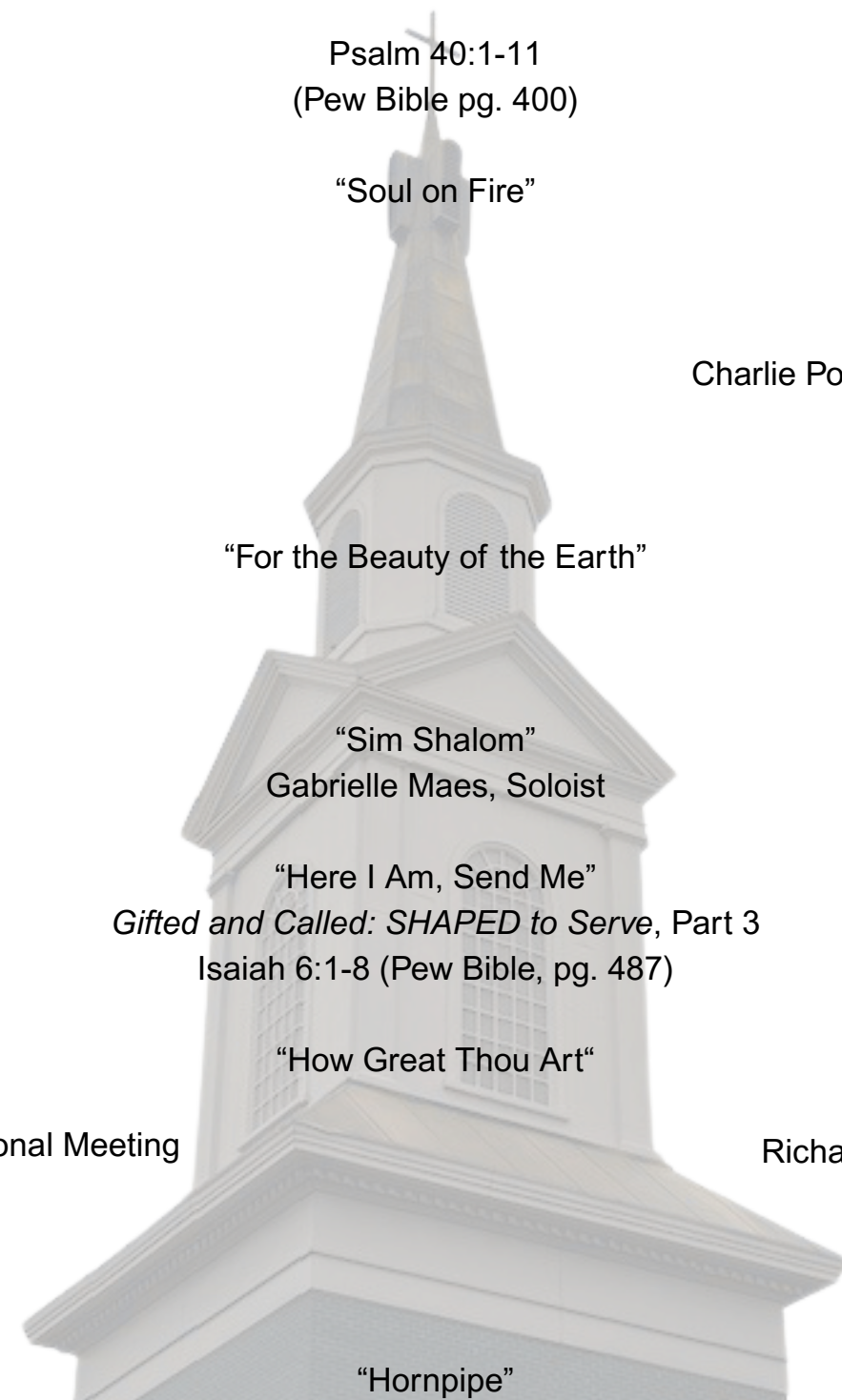

### Call to Action from Isaiah 6:1-8

1. \_\_\_\_\_: *Your gifts are meant to be shared.*
  - Consider the gifts, talents, and time God has entrusted to you.
  - Ask yourself: “Where is God calling me to serve right now?”
2. \_\_\_\_\_: *Say yes to God.*
  - Respond to God’s call with a prayer of availability: “Lord, here I am. Send me.”
  - Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance and courage.
3. \_\_\_\_\_: *Faithful action matters.*
  - Identify one tangible way you can serve this week – in your home, at church, or in the community.
  - Take the first step, no matter how small, trusting that God can multiply your efforts.
