Infant and Childcare

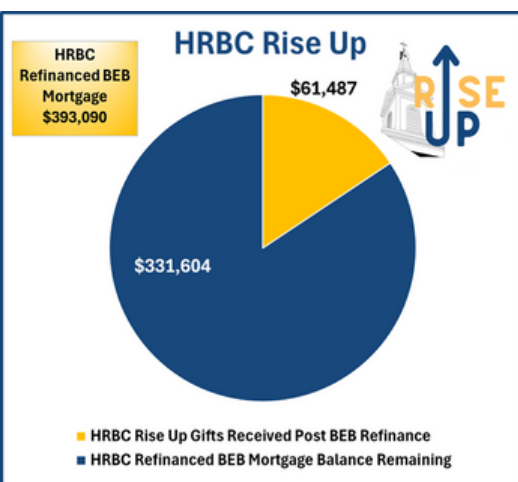
- Worship Care is available for infants through pre-Kindergarten in the Children's Building.
