Adult Bible Study

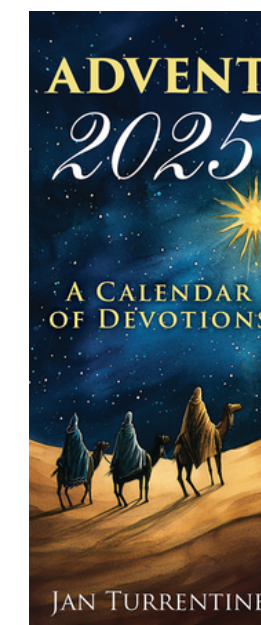
