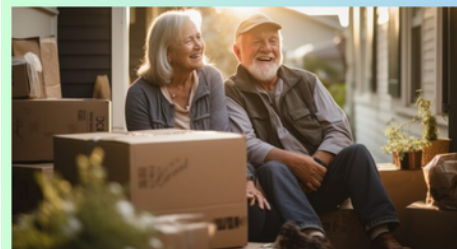


Installation of Rev. David Cameron
